

# Suggested Walks

Please ensure all gates are left closed to exclude animals from collections.

## A Southern Hemisphere 45min, track class 2

Go through the Gondwana Collection to the Western Hill Lookout for views over much of the site. Proceed past the White Gum Grove to the Tasmanian Collection and follow Sylvan Circuit through the European and Eastern Asian Collections to return to the Picnic Area.

## B Lake Circuit 25min, track class 2

This is an easier walk. Proceed through the Fernery around the lake to the European and Eastern Asia collections to return to the Picnic Area. Platypus and waterbirds may be seen. The following deviations can add interest to the above walks. Time additional to above walks.

## C Aotearoa New Zealand 20min, track class 3 Railway and River 45min, track class 3

This track goes across the Don River and around the collection. A view of the Limestone Cliff undercut by water may be had. You can also go down a railway formation through local forest, wildlife may be seen. Return by the same route.

## D Nature Trail 20min, track class 3

Starts from the Lichen Interpretation, near the Tiger Wall. Walk through natural bush to the Don River and along the bank to return; it involves a steep section and steps. Take a trail guide and return to the box at the other end.

## E Limestone Hill 20min, track class 3

Starts from the turnoff to Don River and goes up hill past the Limestone interpretation. Proceed past historic quarry and kiln, through local limestone vegetation and return along Melrose Creek. Track involves steep sections and steps. There are extensive areas of cliffs on the eastern side of Limestone Hill.
