



Conditions of Entry to the Arboretum

To ensure that everyone has an enjoyable time please show consideration for others and observe these Conditions of Entry.

The site is a **Wildlife Sanctuary** (Land for Wildlife). Please do not frighten any of the animals or birds. If observing wild animals do not deliberately disturb their activities.



Children must be supervised by a responsible person at all times.

For safety ball games may only be played in the area in front of the Tree Park Kiosk.

Vehicles used by disabled and elderly visitors may be parked between the Kiosk and Rotunda 2 (adjacent to the Kiosk), all other vehicles are restricted to the Carpark. The elderly or disabled may drive or be driven around Sylvan Circuit, the One Way internal road. Because children, other pedestrians, cyclists and animals also use this road, the **speed limit is 10kmph.**

Dogs must be on leads and under the control of their owners at all times.

Bicycles are restricted to Sylvan Circuit.

Do not enter in or upon any of the waterways including creeks, dams and rivers. Swimming and boating is strictly prohibited.

Fires may only be lit for cooking purposes in the wood fired barbeques. These may not be used on **Total Fire Ban** days.

We depend on volunteers for much of our work and the support of the community for much of our funding. We hold a living collection of plants, each one of them important to us, please respect them. The Arboretum is owned by its members.
